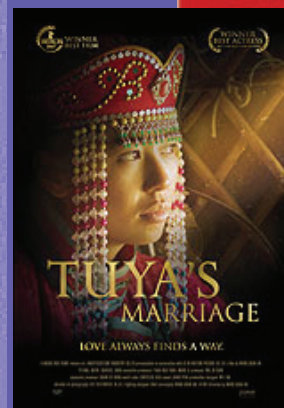
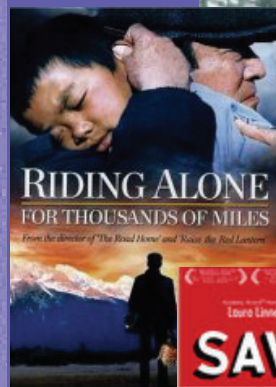


FILM SERIES AT SHELTER ROCK



Fall Film Series: FAMILIES

with Rev. Paul Johnson

This fall film series will feature five films concerning families. The Rev. Dr. Paul S. Johnson, Senior Minister at Shelter Rock, will lead a short discussion after each showing.

All films will be shown on Fridays at 7:30 pm in the Chapel.

October 3 *The Namesake* (USA, 2006)

American-born Gogal, the son of Indian immigrants, wants to fit in among his fellow New Yorkers despite his family's unwillingness to let go of their traditional ways.

October 17. *Junebug* (US 2005).

A dealer in "primitive" art travels from Chicago to North Carolina to meet her new in-laws, challenging the equilibrium of their middle class Southern home.

October 24. *Riding Alone for Thousands of Miles* (China, 2005)

Winner of several awards, this film by Zhang Yimou tells the story of a Japanese father traveling to China's Yunnan Province in the place of his ailing, disaffected son to film a famous folk opera star.

November 21. *The Savages* (US, 2007)

Nominated for two Oscars and winner of nine other awards, and starring Laura Linney and Philip Seymour Hoffman, the film tells the story of a sister and brother facing the familial responsibility of caring for their ailing father.

December 5. *Tuya's Marriage* (China, 2006)

Set in inner Mongolia and winner of four international awards, this film tells the story of a young desert herder forced by circumstances to choose a suitor to take care of her, her two children and her disabled husband. Winner of the top prize at the 2007 Berlin International Film Festival.
